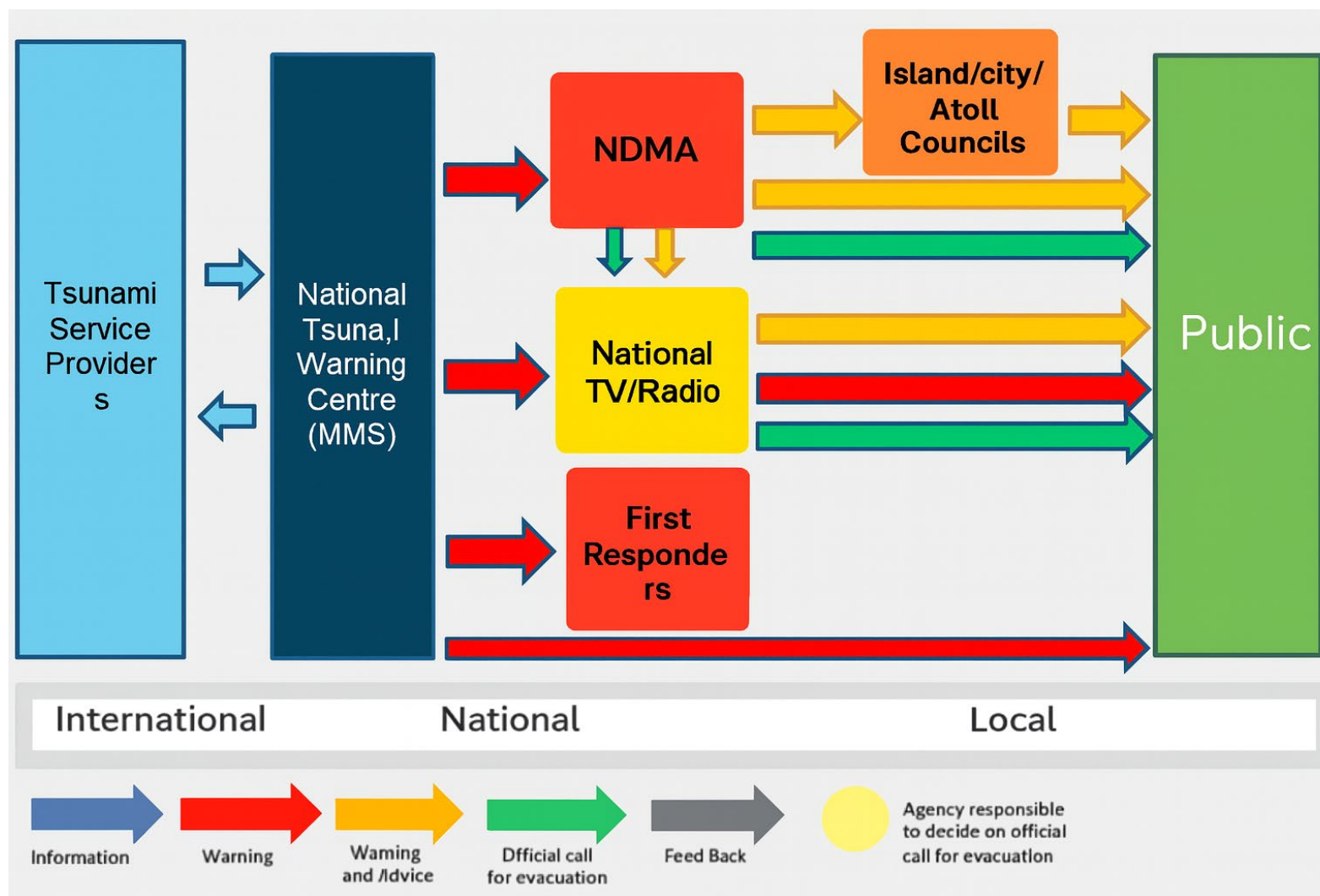




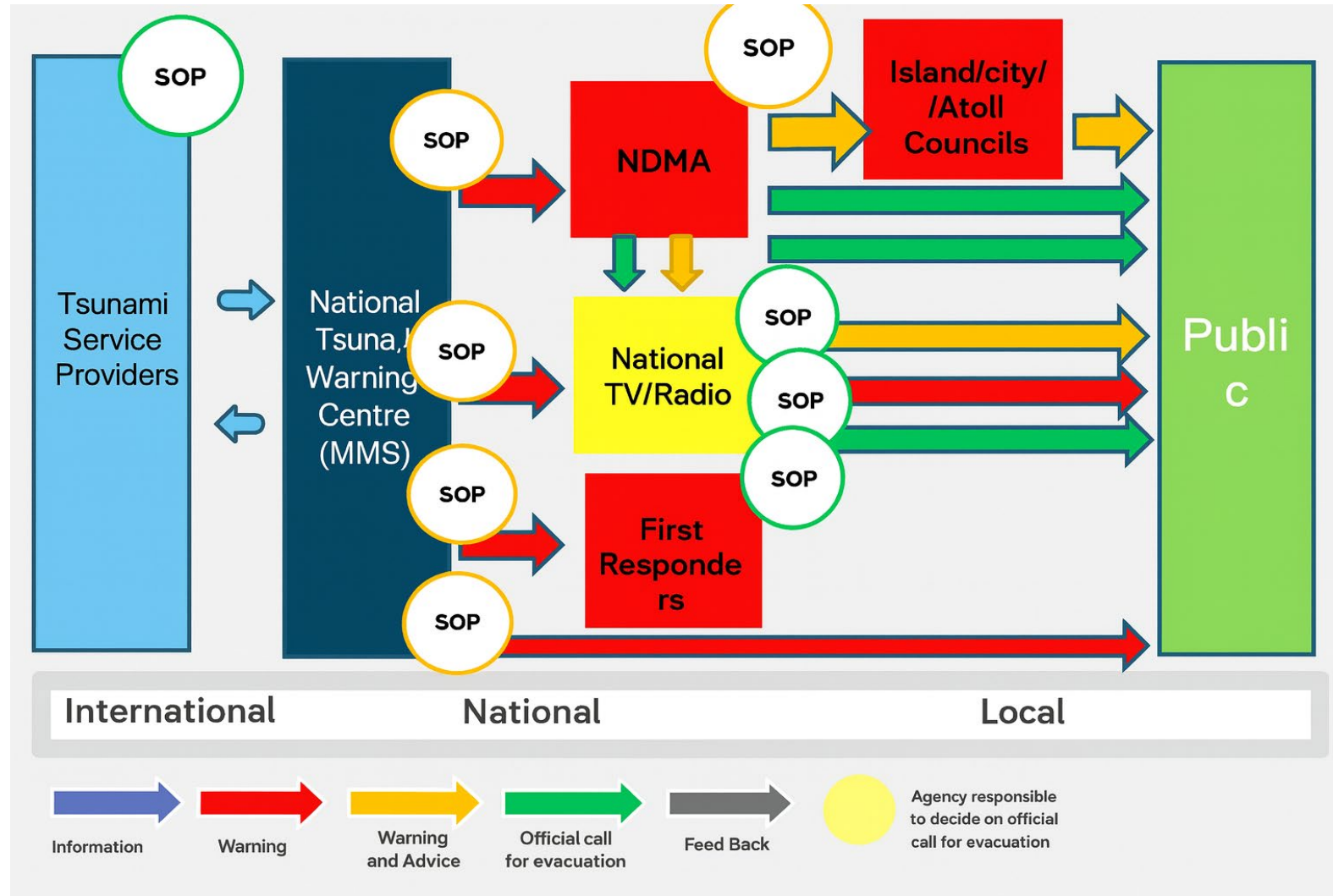

# Issues for follow-up and future work

## 1. Integration of SOPs Across Islands

Ensure all atoll/island councils and response agencies align their procedures with national SOPs.

## 2. Sustainability of Training Programs

Develop a mechanism for regular refresher training for local responders, schools, and resort staff.

## 3. Digital EOCC Dashboard Testing

Continue live-testing of the Emergency Operations Coordination Centre (EOCC) dashboard and incorporate user feedback- System built with support of World Bank.

## 4. Private Sector Engagement

Strengthen coordination with resorts, guesthouses, and transport operators in preparedness and evacuation protocols.

## 5. Data Gaps and Risk Mapping

Improve hazard mapping, sea-level modeling, and community vulnerability assessments.
