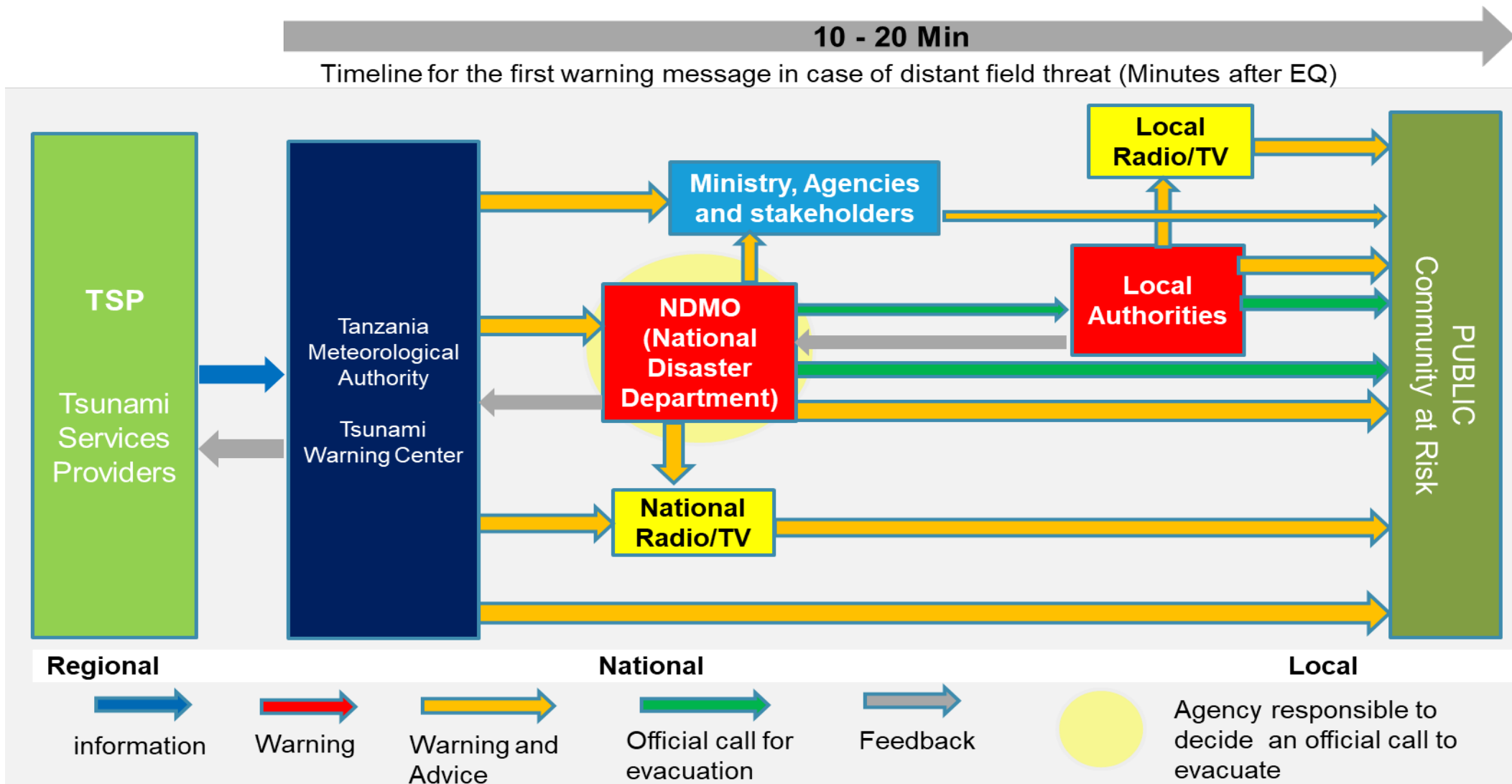

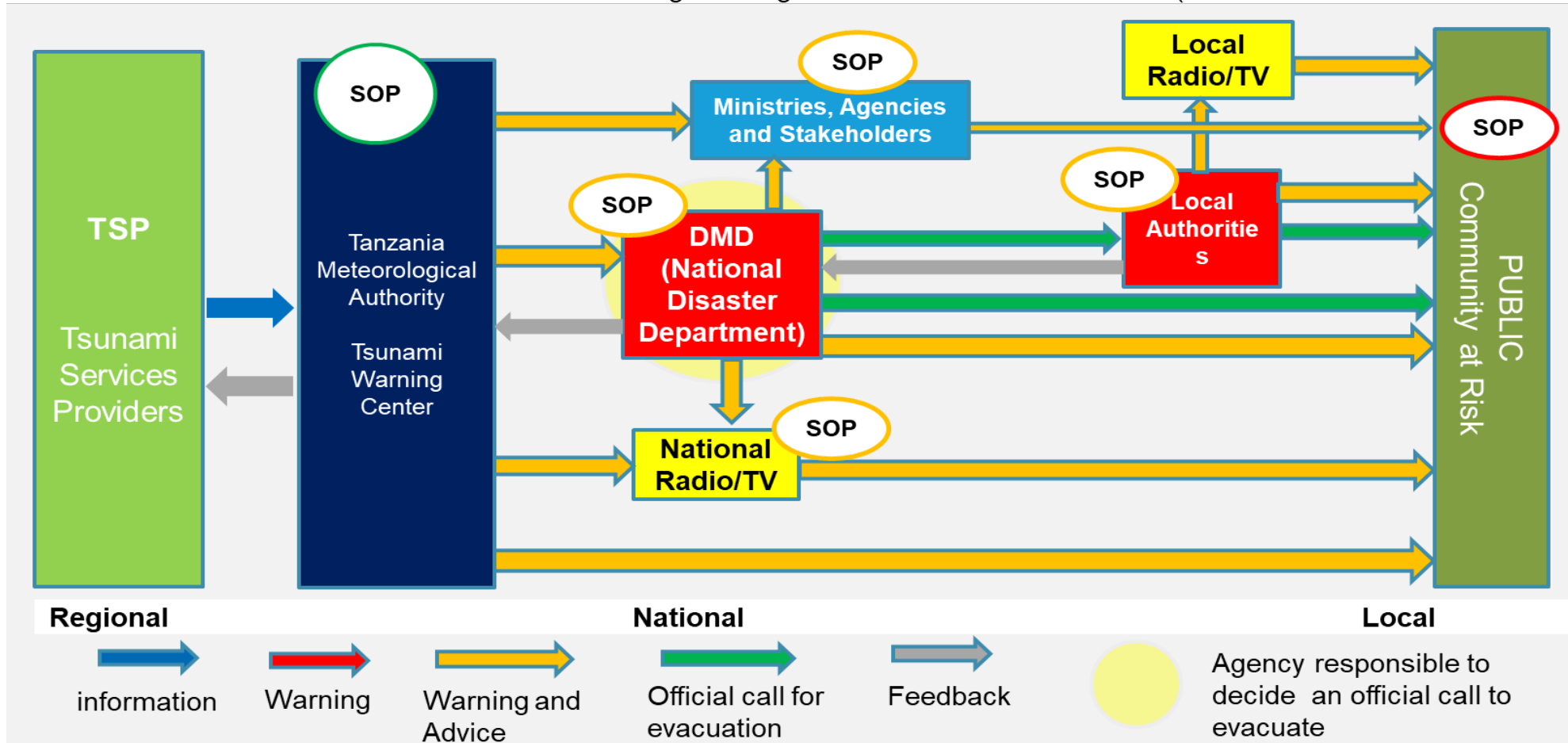

Issues for follow-up and future work

1. Finalizing the review the existing SOPs to reflect the timing for Near and Distant events as well as aligning.
2. Need to Develop SOP for Public.
3. Need to have Siren system to alert communities especially during nights.

 - Sumatra Trench, M9.2, 05 November 2025, 03:00 UTC.
- **Exercise types**
 - Tabletop exercise
- **Key players:**
 - NTWC, N/L DMO, Government Ministries and Agencies, Regional Secretariat and Local Government Authorities, Disaster Management Committees, Emergency Response Agencies, media.

1. Media Awareness Campaign

- Radio, TV, and social media broadcasts on tsunami risk, safety tips, and evacuation procedures.
- Production and dissemination of posters, leaflets, and infographics in Kiswahili and English.

2. School Outreach Programmes

- Interactive tsunami preparedness sessions in selected coastal schools.
- Distribution of children-friendly learning materials.



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
