








Standard Operating Procedure Status Timor–Leste



Issues for follow-up and future work



- 1. Updating outdated SOPs for tsunami warnings (Ongoing)
- 2. Improving coordination between NTWC and local DMOs
- 3. Training internal CPA and local communities on evacuation procedures
- 4. Coordination between national TV and the Telecommunication Operator for the dissemination of warning information. (ongoing)
- 5. Testing communication channels during drills
- 6. Securing funding for siren maintenance or new equipment
