- **Q1.** Is an annual report required from each NFP? If yes, what should be included that avoids duplication of effort (since countries submit multiple annual reports for ocean observing networks etc.). Should reporting contain information that the IOC-UNESCO country reps would find useful for their annual meeting (keeping them abreast of all ocean obs activity in each country)? Should the reporting template (content) be co-created with the national IOC-UNESCO reps.?
- **Q2.** Would a welcome pack for new joiners be useful to the NFPs?
- **Q3.** What kind of activities are expected to be accomplished by the NFP? What does SC imagine that NFP could do, despite the Terms of Reference? Considering that the ToR could be ambitious for beginners or new NFPs.
